On behalf of the **FPEA Homeschool Foundation** and the **Florida Parent-Educators Association**, I congratulate you on completing your home-education program with distinction.

The qualifications for each of the scholarships sponsored by the Foundation, and instructions for submitting applications for them, are described below. Please choose the scholarship(s) you think you qualify for at this time — the Foundation reserves the right to consider applicants for different scholarships than those for which they applied.

Descriptions and Qualifications

CHRISTOPHER J. KLICKA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (academic and service)

This is a one-time award of \$2,000 to a student who has excelled academically and has generously served his/her community. Applicants must be graduating seniors, Florida residents and current FPEA members home-educated for all four years of high school. Applicants must graduate and begin an educational program at a college or university no later than fall 2010. Children of FPEA and/or Foundation board members are not eligible.

The FPEA Foundation will take into consideration the candidate's application, references, service experience, essay, homeschool transcript and selected test scores. Only the requested materials will be reviewed; no others will be considered.

FPEA ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

This is a one-time award of \$1,500 given to an outstanding individual who has excelled academically. Applicants must be graduating seniors, Florida residents and current FPEA members home-educated for all four years of high school. Applicants must graduate and begin an educational program at a college or university no later than fall 2010. Children of FPEA and/or Foundation board members are not eligible.

The Foundation will take into account the candidate's application, service experience, references, homeschool transcript and autobiography. Only the requested materials will be reviewed; no others will be considered.

FPEA VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship awards \$1,500 to a homeschooled student who plans to study at a trade or vocational school past high school. Applicants must have been homeschooled all four years of high school and demonstrate an interest in a trade. Applicants must graduate and begin an educational program at a vocational or trade school no later than fall 2010. Children of FPEA and/or Foundation board members are not eligible.

The Foundation will take into consideration the candidate's application, references, autobiography, homeschool transcript, and vocational or trade school interest. Only the requested

materials will be reviewed; no others will be considered.

General Instructions

To apply for any one of these scholarships, completely fill out and submit the application along with any required supporting materials. Only one application is needed, no matter the number of scholarships you wish to apply for. Submitted materials cannot be returned. Applications must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2010. We will notify you if you are a scholarship recipient.
